Curriculum vitae Prof. Dr. Alfred Gossner, CFO of Fraunhofer-Gesellschaft, Munich

After completing an Economics degree at the Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich and the University of Lancaster and a Philosophy degree at the Munich School of Philosophy SJ, as well as a research residency with a Rhodes scholarship at the University of Oxford, Prof. Dr. Gossner then worked as a research assistant at the Faculty of Economics of Munich University. After earning his doctorate, he started his career at an international business consultancy in 1983. This was followed by sixteen years, starting from 1985, in various management positions at the Allianz Group, including as Group Managing Director (CEO) of Allianz South Africa, Johannesburg, and Allianz Namibia, Windhoek. Back in Germany, he took up the position of Chairman of the Management of Allianz Northern Germany in 1996 before being appointed as a member of the Management Board of Allianz Versicherungs-AG in 1999. In 2002, Prof. Dr. Gossner moved to the Management Board of Fraunhofer-Gesellschaft, where he is responsible for the areas of finance, controlling and information technology. In his role as Chairman of the Supervisory Board of First Sensor AG, Prof. Dr. Gossner can also contribute his experience from supervisory board mandates for Germanische Lloyd AG, Karstadt Warenhaus AG and the Allianz Group.
